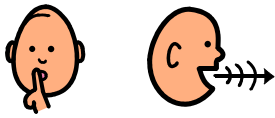
There are some rules that people follow when



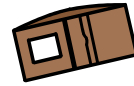
they are learning to ride the bus and when they ride the



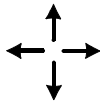
bus alone. These are the rules:



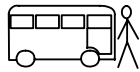
1- Use a quiet voice and polite language.



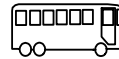
2- Carry your pass or money in your wallet.



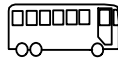
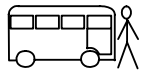
3- Listen carefully to the directions from your teacher, your



assistant or the bus driver.

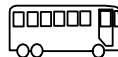


4- Wait calmly and quietly for your bus.



5- Show the bus driver your bus pass or put your money

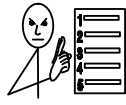
in the meter.
